

# Shipton Moyne Parish Council

Minutes of the Council meeting held on the Tuesday 27<sup>th</sup> June 2017 in the Village Hall, Shipton Moyne.

- 1. To allow public consultation –** None present.
- 2. To receive and accept any apologies for absence –** Cllr O’Keeffe
- 3. To receive amendments to members register of interests and declarations of interest to items on the agenda -** None.
- 4. To consider and agree purchase and position of a defibrillator for the benefit of the village also to agree finance for same (application for grant submitted to CDC) –**
  - Cllr Clark explained that the Cat and Custard Pot had agreed to house a defibrillator at the back entrance to the pub and to pay for the electrician to set up the unit. (The position has been agreed with K Dickens of the ambulance service).
  - He also pointed out that the manager and assistant manager are trained First Aiders the manager has also received training on a defibrillator (Training for anyone who wants is included with the package).
  - Cllr Clark will also put a piece in the village newsletter informing the village of the intention to purchase the defibrillator and asking for donations to the cost (any excess to be earmarked for future maintenance of the unit).
  - Cllr O’Keeffe had noted his support for the project to the chair.
  - Questions were asked about the security of the equipment and how often it will need servicing. Cllr Clark to seek answers and advise.

Following some further discussion it was agreed by all to purchase a defibrillator to be sited at the Cat and Custard Pot with the aid of the CDC grant and any donations from the community with the balance to be paid by the Parish Council.
