Minutes of the Annual Parish meeting held on the Tuesday 8th May 2018 in the Village Hall, Shipton Moyne.

1. Apologies.

Apologies were received from the Police, County Councillor Hirst and Cllr M O'Keeffe

2. To approve the minutes of the meeting of the 2nd May 2017

The minutes having been previously circulated were agreed.

3. To receive the Chairman's report: Cllr Clark thanked Cllr Hallpike for his support as deputy chair. The main issue over the past year has been the works at Cranmore Farm which are in line to finish on the main house in August; work on the dressage area is well advanced and most of the project should be completed in December. There has been no disruption in the village with the works owing to the due diligence shown by the contractors.

The fitting of the defibrillator at the village hall had been a success with the generosity of the village over subscribing the cost.

After a meeting with the GCC highways manager it was agreed gateways were the only option as a speed warning on entering the village (the village did not meet the criteria for more advanced warnings).

Grass cutting in the Recreation ground has been relet to a new contractor and is progressing well.

The ROSPA inspection of the play area is due shortly and it is expected work will be needed on various pieces of equipment. Cllr Heaven is seeking grant monies from CDC towards replacements.

Nothing heard of broadband upgrade.
