

# Shipton Moyne Parish Council

To allow public consultation** – Patrick Tierney explained he has received a circular from a company offering fibre-optic internet to customers which is dependent on local support and enquired if Council was aware. Cllr Clark gave an outline of his latest communication with Fastershire stating all news is available on their web site and Shipton Moyne should be connected in 2020. Mr and Mrs Tierney agreed Fastershire is the best way forward
