

Shipton Moyne Parish Council

Minutes of the Council meeting held on the Tuesday 6th August 2019 in the Village Hall, Shipton Moyne.

Present: Cllrs C Hallpike (Chair), D Gibbings, Anne Carr-Jones, P Kass, B Birdwood, County Councillor S Hirst, District Cllr N Ind, and the Clerk Mrs. J Hunt.

- 1. To allow public consultation – None**
- 2. To receive and accept any apologies for absence – None received**
- 3. To receive amendments to members register of interests and declarations of interest to items on the agenda – None**
- 4. To agree minutes of the 25th June 2019 – Minutes were agreed as presented.**

Matters arising from the minutes and not on the agenda –** It was agreed to contact R Gray (Highways) with a view to having the gates at the entrance to the village on the Tetbury Road made the same size and to enquire if a refund was payable as payment had been made towards the cost of 4 full size gates. Southside resurfacing had taken place, thanks were expressed to the District and County Councillors. Compliments have been received on the much improved play area. P Nicholls had asked if he could buy a small bay to position in the corner of the recreation ground to dispose of the grass cuttings – agreed.
- 6. Report from County Councillor S Hirst –** Nothing to report. Councillors still have concerns over pot holes in Hedgeditch lane and on Tetbury Road near the entrance to Close Farm. Concern was also expressed on the state of the pavements in the village.
- 7. Report from District Councillor N Ind –** CDC has a Climate emergency policy and Tetbury Town Council are producing a climate strategy. The Valley Trading application is undergoing more scrutiny. The budget surplus will be used for the new waste service starting in the autumn. Tetbury Care is looking at general care in the community for all ages, their next meeting is in October.

- 9. Report on Gigaclear progress –** Following the successful meeting with Stephen Harris a report had been put on the website and will be in the next Village Newsletter. The Chairman to keep the village up dated on progress via S Harris.
