

Shipton Moyne Parish Council

Minutes of the Council meeting held on the Tuesday 3rd August 2021 in the Village Hall, Shipton Moyne.

Prior to the start of the meeting Sally Nicholls the new Cotswold Warden for the parish gave a brief introduction to the work of the Wardens.

- 2. To receive and accept any apologies for absence** – County Cllr Hirst both sent apologies on 4th August.

- 7. Report from District Councillor N Ind** – Cllr Ind had had a virtual meeting with Gigaclear and it is anticipated the remaining problems would be resolved in the Autumn. Talk of affordable housing in the village was exploratory at the present time, CDC have been told to contact Cllr Hallpike to discuss further. Clerk to put in application to Gigaclear for a community hub connection.
- 8. To note recreation ground accounts** – Bank balance £4676. New water heater has been fitted. Cllrs are concerned at the state of Cranmore Lane, Cllr Hallpike to speak to Cllr Hirst.
