6. Finance report – The RFO reported the final balance for the year was £5652.96, slightly increased on last year. Grass cutting of the Recreation Ground is expected to increase this year due to the rising fuel costs. The Recreation Ground has a balance of £3945.74 slightly down on last year. The Football Club have been invoiced for hire of the pitches and use of electric and water. It was agreed to look at the charge for the hire of the pitches – June agenda.

7. Chairman’s report – During the year P Kass had moved away from the village and L Rose had replaced him on the council. He thanked County Highways for the much needed work on the Tetbury Road. The boundary dispute with Westonbirt with Lasborough was awaiting a decision from CDC.
